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Code of Conduct

Anona Center Inc. is a separate entity from Alcoholics Anonymous and therefore is not governed by the "12 Traditions" of Alcoholics Anonymous. However, problems within meetings and between are dealt with by the use of Alcoholics Anonymous "12 Traditions".

We at Anona Center Inc. want to provide a safe and welcoming environment for those who are trying to advance their recovery. With that in mind there are some simple rules to abide by when you visit the Center. All persons using the Anona facility are expected to conduct themselves in a responsible and respectful manner. Members and Guests are welcome if they have a desire to follow this Code of Conduct.

All persons are expected to follow the directions of the Administrative Boards, who oversee the daily operation of the club.

- 1) No drugs or alcoholic beverages are permitted on the premises.
- 2) There shall be no gambling.
- 3) Theft or willful destruction of property will not be tolerated.
- 4) Violence against any person, verbal or physical will not be tolerated.
- 5) Firearms and or weapons of any kind are not allowed.
- 6) Sexually suggestive comments or the possession of sexually explicit materials in any form will not be tolerated.
- 7) Children are the sole responsibility of the adult(s) who brought them to the Center. The adults will be held accountable for the child's behavior.
- 8) Pets are not allowed.
- 9) Panhandling is not allowed.
- 10) Storage of personal belongings is not allowed.
- 11) Overnight use of the facility is not allowed. (Including sleeping and loitering)
- 12) Smoking areas are outside the Center 15 feet away from any door.
- 13) Solicitation of funds on the premises for non-A.A. related organizations or the offering for sale of any items not specifically approved by the Operating Board is forbidden.
- 14) All non-members and guests of members are only permitted in the Center 30 minutes before and after meetings. Unless accompanied by a member of the club.

Violations of any of the Code will result in disciplinary actions. The extent of the action will be at the discretion of the Operating Board.
